Thursday 10th September 015:

was terrible because of the Roadworkers &
the Holiday Traffic it was a Nightmare:
it only got better, when we went past

was, it was holded up a bit for 5 minutes
because of a Ice Cream Trailor needing
to be Connected to the Car, and
then the Bus started up again:
It went through to Trevalles: Liskey

perran Sands Holiday park, What a eyesore that place was, it looked out of place, and it went to Goonhavern - Reterrah Treloggan - Trenance - to Newquay because of the roadworkers, and the silly Holiday Traffic it made me miss my Connection from Newquay to Wadebridge which I suppose I should of gotten at 6:10pm the 94 Bus to Wadebridge from Newquay Bus station: I got there at 6:20 pm or 6:30 pm making me miss the vital Connection, and I missed the 93 Bus to St Columb Major at 6:30 pm and thought about walking all the way to Wadebridge; I decided that I had enough of waiting, so I thought that I leave Newquay behind because I couldn't stand it any longer, and couldn't stand the place and felt better when I was walking so I carried on the 16 miles to Newquay, and the Copper gave me a lift about 4 miles to Wadebridge: It was hairraising being on the A39 Road

this dog from Newbury, Berkshire

to Royal Berkshire Hospital in Reading
for 4 Weeks I was on clutches,
I told her that it plays up
in Winter & it drops the knee cap
plays up: That's why I got a Bus pass:
& said Bye to them: The first
Bus left Bodmin at 10:27 am heading
for to go to Plymouth: The Sad story
story was that it brock down half way
near the petrol station: & It wasn't
untill another hour, that another
Bus came along at 11:27 am, but
what a drama, I was talking to this
Man, he was friendly & we was
talking about everything, & also about
the Bus breaking down, & we laught
about it: The other people on the
Bus was a bit upset by it, some
went to have something to eat & one went
to have a coffee, but most waited outside

It wasn't untill 11:27 am, that the
other bus arrived, & we were
~~that~~ excited and happy, once being
on the Bus, and arrived in Plymouth
at 12:27 pm: I said good bye to a
friend that I spoke to all the way
from Bodmin to Plymouth, & then
went to ~~the~~ Plymouth Royal ~~Platode~~
Bus stop: ~~the~~ I got off, and bought
some food, & drink & went to the Cafe
and ordered a Vegan Breakfast & a Cup
of coffee; and got on the Bus from
Plymouth — Buckfastleigh and left
at 2:55 pm a Stagecoach X38 that arrived
at 3:42 pm; at Buckfastleigh: Silly me
I forgotten to pick up my mobile phone
& it was on the X38 Bus heading for
Exeter: So I thought I better wait
around to see if its still in the Bus
and waited till 5:45 pm, & it wasn't
on the bus, but he said phone the
Bus station at Exeter; & I said
I find a way of phoning them on
someone phone; because I haven't had my phone
on me

I thought I go to Buckfast Abbey, and Test there Charity. It was very nice of him to do that for me: It had Mashed potato & Curried Lentils with some vegetables, it was nice & lovely, and had some fruit & he gave me a cup of ~~Herb~~ Herb Tea after he asked me, what drink did I want, I said a Herb Tea, and he said would green tea do you, & I said yes that would do: I had my Dinner & said Thank you Before hand, & he said Breakfast will be in the Morning: I made up my Bed. Rolled it out & slept in my sleeping Bag: It was raining outside, & I said to myself How I glad to have a roof over my head; and slept well, & I woke up in the Morning, I had a small wash put on my clothes on: Breakfast was a bit late: I rolled my Bed Roll up & tried it all up, He said We normally have

eggs on Toast, meaning Hard Boiled
eggs with Toast: & he said he can
do Marmite with Toast, & a Cup
of Coffee, & I said that will do:
He brought the Tray out & There
was also some fruit on there,
That was kind of him, and thought
to myself, I must supple there
Vine, there, I been told by a
Local that it is strong: I said
Thank you for the Breakfast, & he
Wished me luck on My Journey:
& I said good Bye ^{to them}: I thought
to my self, What a bunch of
lovely people that these Monks
were, & that they really Welcome
Wayfarers meaning Travelers: That
is Very good of the Monks to
do that, & it made me thought
that they really do care about
people: Before hand I said Thank you
for having me here: I then went
to Buckfastleigh Railway Station
On a Saturday morning:

Saturday 12th September 015.

I got some food from the
petrol station, & made my way to
Buckfastleigh Railway Station: & had
a look at the ^{Train} Museum: It was interesting
having a look at all the old train
information, and the history of the Old
Railways: I bought a Great Western
Train picture, & a King George Train
Badge all together for £3: I hopped
on the Stream train going to Straton
& I didnt realise that it was £14
for a all day Ticket to go on as
many trains as you want: So I payed
at Straton of £14 plus to get a
Cup of Coffee, a packet of Crisp; &
I hopped on to Totnes, the Stream
train going to Totnes: I waited for it
to arrive at Straton: Straton was a
lovely Train station with all the Charm
& Splendar of everything that was old fashioned
It was like going back in time; plus two
old fashioned Bikes one was a philips
1940's Ladies 3 speed Pushbike; I think the other one
was a Raleigh.

the ^{stream} train experiences: It made me
want to go again for the 31st October
— 1st November: which will be half
price £7 for the 31st October &
£7 for the 1st of November 015:

I ~~got~~ went to Buchfastleigh Town
Center, after leaving the Train station
& said good bye to them all, I
bought some food to eat, and I
had a look at the Town quite a lot
of shops, a park, & lots of history
about the place: & I found a Tin shack
after walking back, and slept there that
Night, about ¼ mile away from ~~Buchfast~~
Abbey:

Sunday 13th September 015:

I woke up early first light,
& started getting myself ready to have
a walk about, I walked to the petrol
station, and there was toilets there, I
decide to use the toilet, & plus to
get cleaned up, the lady nearly walked
in, luckily I had my Jeans on: I

& I walked down to the Town center
had a look at the shops, and bought
some food ^{& drink} from the shop, & walked back the
station was open about 9 something & asked

if I can leave it there for a while, & he said, as long you come back to pick it up before 5pm
It will be all right: I had a Breakfast in the Cafe: & I asked for a Vegan Breakfast: I only got Hush Browns, Beans on Toast & a Cup of Coffee for £3 something: I asked them to put oil on my Toast & she said would Olive oil do: I said of course that would do: I had my Breakfast, and decide to see, How & Whereabouts to see the trains; but Straton & Tobnes was 4-5 miles aways: So I decided to come back, and get my things & walk up to Buchfastleigh Steps that someone told me about: I walked up 194 steps to the Church before hand I bought chips for myself & incense ^{White Sage} & a white candle & matches and told the lady at the New age shop, that I want to bless the church & bring in good energy & she said thats a great idea: I said good Bye to

her, & walked up the 194 steps to this lovely old 1411 Church that was quite old, it got Burnt in 1992 by Vandals; there was a pouchway there with a roof & I slept in there, I rolled out my Mat there before hand I had a nice walk down to Buchfast & to Hamelwell Woods: It was beautiful with fantastic views all around when you got to the top lots & lots of Beautiful Trees of all shapes & Sizes A proper forest, that was full of Trees & Grasslands when you got to the very top: It was well worth the effort: A view of all the Countrysides & hiftside & Trees in the distance, and then I walked down to find the River path through lovely avenue of trees, and paths that were Muddy in part; I saw Black Beetles in the ground shifting all the Horse Dung, & making it fine material for there borrowing: quite clever Beetles

stop was to wait 10 minutes; and the
bus arrived: It was going to Exeter
Bus station: I thought thats alright,
after I lost my mobile phone
on Friday Afternoon, because of
my forgetfulness: I asked the Lady
if I can borrow the phone to
ring up this was on Saturday
Morning; but the Message was
that it was open from Monday
— Friday 9 am — 5 pm; and thats
Why I had to go there for
Monday Morning to see if
anyone handled in my mobile
phone; and the bus driver
Reconcise me, Said to me, I
handled in your phone in the
Lost Property Bus station, &

its in there, When I went down
there, I asked for my Mobile phone
and told them that it was a white
phone; & they said is it a Samsung
& I said yes: They wanted me
too sign my name; and I got it
back, & I said Thank you: &
Caught the Totnes bus from Exeter
that went ~~from~~ ^{to} Totnes: I thought
I got to see for myself what
Totnes looked like, it was a
historic town, when I walked up
the streets, and went to Willows
too have a Herb Tea, it was nice
& walked down the hill, & walked
to a Christian place where they
were giving Coffee's & biscuits, ~~for~~
for free: So I went in there, and
ordered a cup of Coffee, and the
atmosphere was very friendly, I
met a Traveler that have traveled
everywhere & he still does what
is amazing: Even the people that
Run the Place were friendly too

Its like I got on well
with all of them, & talked
untill it was time to go,
because it closed at 12:30pm:
I went back down the Road

his dog was with his girlfriend
I ~~at~~ walked where there was
a Health Shop, asked asked if
she had any Reduced stuff
there, & she gave me a Vegan
Wrap Roll; after I bought a
Round Vegan fridge cake: I said
Thank you to her, & I
Thought I Must ~~get~~ ~~to~~
the Bridge at Totnes, &
have my Lunch there,
after I was speaking to a
lovely Vegan Lady on the bus
to Totnes, she told me that
she lives at Dartmouth,
& her husband owns a boat
in Dartmouth River & lives

in a boat there. she was a
Beautiful Lady, & she said to
me, have you eaten much, I
said not much, I been living on
Junk food, & she said thats not
good, & she said do you like
Homous, I said yes. She said I
bought 2. You can have one,
& do you like ~~she said~~ Sunflower sprouts
& Catcakes, & I said I love
those food: She was genous &
loved giving, & I said do you want
everything for them, she said No
I'm giving them to you, because
I'm so happy, I practice Buddism
every day, & its made my Life
so clear, & focused, it brings
about change in the World to
Create peace in our World,
she said, & I said I know a
friend from Oxford that does
Buddism, her name is Joolz
I done bits of Buddism I
said to her, but I will get

back at doing Buddhism
again, I said to her, & she
said, please do so, It will
make you happy & fulfilled:
I told her about the Buses
On Saturday 19th September at
Kingsbridge at 10 am & its
all free, & she said, she would
love to go to that, & she said
she love to bring her partner
along to it, and I told her
about the Buckfastleigh Stream Train
that goes from Buckfastleigh -
Stratton - to Totnes; & that its
worth going to, & said its about
£14 to go to it, but it will be
half price in October 31st
November 1st, It will only be
£7 each day: she said thats
better; she said she like to
go to that: I said to her
that Im going to try, and
make it up for that time
We had a wonderfull time

talking, I said to her I see
you at Kingsbridge on Saturday
she said that, she try and
make it there: I said good Bye
to her; & said Thank you to her
for the food, she said thats alright
I want to give you something to eat.
enjoy the Rest of the Day, she
said, Totnes is a place to visit
you must visit Totnes, you would
fit in at Totnes: I Thanked her
again & said good Bye: I headed
towards the Bridge, & underneath I
had my Lunch there, it was lovely
The River was beautiful & sparkling,
The Bridge was Ancient & still
standing all those years: I had
something to eat & drink: I phoned
Rachel, & said to her, that they dont
reconcise her friend, after Rachel
said a name of the person, that she
remembered that came for one night
only at the Chalet at Tregeseal
& that he was fasting & walking huge

distances along the footpaths:
& I said they don't know him:
she said, Oh well it must be New
people running it: I had to get
my mobile phone charged up &
go to a shop called Go Mobile
to get it charged up: So I
took it in there, & Ask if
they did secondhand mobile
phones & he said No he
doesn't, then I said How much
it cost to charge up this phone
& he said it will cost you
£1 to charge it up, I thought
that's alright: He said Come back
in a hour, & it will be ready
So I ordered a Herb Tea from
the Cafe Racer Bar & bought
a Herb Tea for £1.80p &
can have top up afterwards
I was watching the world go
bye drinking 4 cups of Tea
in 1 hour: & observing
people, & their culture

It really is a amazing place
but I don't think I could
live in a town, because I
like the quietness of Villages
& Hamlets & the Countryside,
is what moves me the most:
& Seeing different places &
different areas of the County:
I then got my phone, and made
my way to catch a Bus to
Kingsbridge; I got on the Bus to
go to Kingsbridge, it was a local Bus
Company called Tally Ho: It arrived
at Kingsbridge: I made some inquiries
at the Bus station, and asked if they
was any woods nearby, & she said
there is its at West Allington;
& there a shop behind the pub:
after I asked her if there was any
shops there, so I walked up to the
Village of West Allington, I found
the Village pub & the shop opposite
there wasn't much there, so I ordered
Two Tins of Beans, & something else

I then payed with my Money
The Locals Were Very friendly
after I asked, How I get to

another place thats suitable:

not far away: I made up my
Bed, I had chips & Beans &
Mixed peanuts for my dinner &
